## 2015 LNG in BC Conference – Made in BC Technology Forum Concept Paper

The Made in BC Technology Forum will take place October 14 - 16 alongside the LNG in BC Conference as a way to showcase B.C.'s vibrant technology industry and our world-class research and innovation infrastructure. By combining these two events, international investors from all over the world will see first-hand B.C.'s competitive advantage not just in the LNG sector but also as a destination for technology investment. B.C. technology and research organizations will be provided an unprecedented opportunity to connect directly with the international investment community and promote their products and solutions to over 3000 participants from across the globe.

This forum will provide B.C. technology enterprises and research institutes an opportunity to demonstrate industry leadership, engage with youth and First Nations communities, showcase success stories and present case studies which demonstrate technical excellence while leveraging international exposure through the LNG in BC Conference attendance.

Space at the Vancouver Convention Centre will be dedicated to four concurrent themes:

- Clean technology
- Information and communication technologies (ICT) and wireless
- Digital and screen-based media

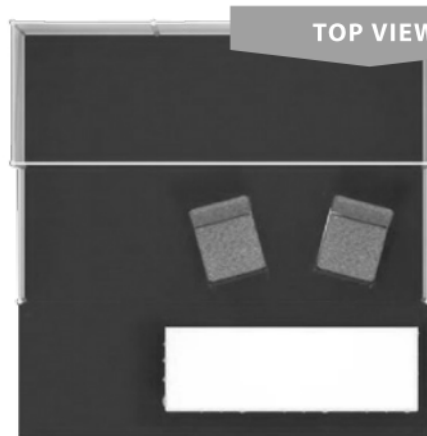
